LDEOC/EOEC SURVEILLANCE PANEL

OHT described the process they use to procure new elastomer batches. They try and maintain a 6 month inventory at all times. During periods of high demand they will not allow one lab to buy up all the inventory. Rather they distribute material in a fair, equitable fashion. Two of the three primary labs have submitted LDEOCS data to TMC for statistical evaluation. The third lab, lab B, has not submitted any data to date. The SP chair will contact the delinquent lab. The batch approval process was discussed. Since there have been no issues with new batches not meeting the current reference limits in several years, Joe Franklin proposed that current limits be maintained, and there is no need for a batch approval process. New batches of material will be run against current limits, and if any lab experiences any sort of issues, they need to contact the surveillance panel chair immediately. Doyle Boese and Mike Kasimirsky confirmed that the batch of material has little to no measurable effect on data, primarily because any batch-to-batch differences that might exist are overwhelmed by lab-to-lab differences. The surveillance panel chair will put the process of maintaining current limits in writing so it can be voted on. More discussion ensued on the lab to lab variable nature of the test, and possible causes.
