MINUTES

1.0 Call to Order

- 1.1 Chairman Jim McGeehan called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m. on December 4, 2001, in the Fontainebleau Ballroom B of the Fontainebleau Hilton Hotel in Miami Beach, Florida. There were 12 members present or represented and approximately 60 guests present. The attendance list is shown as Attachment 2.

2.0 Agenda

- 2.1 The published agenda (Attachment 1) was reviewed, with no suggested changes.

3.0 Previous Meeting Minutes

- 3.1 The minutes of the October 16, 2001 meeting were approved, as posted on the ASTM Test Monitoring Center web site.

4.0 Membership

- 4.1 There were no changes in membership. Several guests registered changes in addresses and affiliations.

5.0 "B" Ballot on CI-4

- 5.1 Chairman McGeehan reported the results of the recent "B" ballot on CI-4 (Attachment 3). The ballot was successful, but there are two negatives and several comments to be addressed.
- 5.2 Lyle Bowman discussed the reasons for his negative ballot return (see Attachment 4). He took issue with use of the term "anchor" in relation to the Mack T-10 merit system. Lyle moved to replace the term "anchor" in all instances connected to the Mack T-10 merit system, with the term "target". Amy Huang seconded the motion, which passed via voice vote with none against and no abstentions.
- 5.3 Jim McGeehan reviewed the known needed editorial corrections, which were discovered and communicated to the D02.B0 membership prior to closure of the ballot (Attachment 5). Pat Fetterman moved that these corrections be adopted and Lew Williams seconded the motion, which passed via voice vote with none against and no abstentions.
- 5.4 Tom Cousineau reviewed the Ethyl negative ballot reasons and comments (Attachment 6). Tom moved and Dwayne Tharp seconded that the decimal points in the WDR and WDN limits be removed and the limits be set at the appropriately rounded whole number. The motion passed after some discussion, via voice vote, with none against and one abstention.
- 5.5 The panel agreed that the phrase "normalized to 1.75% soot" appended to "Average Liner Wear" in the T-10 table A10.2 was in error and should be removed.
- 5.6 Tom Cousineau moved that Oil Consumption should be removed as a Sequence III-F pass / fail limit for CI-4, because it is a validity requirement for the test now. Pat Fetterman seconded the motion, which passed via voice vote, with none against and no abstentions.
- 5.7 After some discussion, Ethyl and Infineum withdrew their requests to have the "minimums" also listed in the Mack T-10 merit table (A10.2) and John Zalar answered Ethyl's concern about the seemingly inconsistent use of decimal places in table A10.1. Several of Ethyl's editorial observations apply to previous, established categories and as such, were not dealt with at this time. The other editorial observations will be incorporated where possible and appropriate.
- 5.8 Rich Lee moved that for the 1R, the three test limit for TLC should be 36 and for the M-11 EGR, the two test and three test limits for OFDP should be 320 and 341. Steve Kennedy seconded the motion, which passed via voice vote with none against and no abstentions.

- 5.9 After some discussion, the panel agreed that the Mack T-10 merit table (A10.2) should stay in D-4485.
- 5.10 Lew Williams had comments about pass / fail parameter terminology. For the M-11 EGR, "Top Ring Weight Loss" should be identified as "Average Top Ring Weight Loss" and for the 1R, "Scuffing, piston-ring-liner" should be changed to "Piston-Ring-Liner Distress", to more accurately reflect what is being evaluated. The panel agreed with these suggestions.
- 5.11 Steve Kennedy moved to remove the 1N from the CI-4 table of pass / fail limits and keep it as a footnote alternative to the 1K. Bill Kleiser seconded this motion, which passed with 11 for, 0 against and 1 abstain.

6.0 Mack T-10

- 6.1 Wim VanDam reported for the T-10 Task Force (now part of the Mack Surveillance Panel). See Attachment 7. Wim moved and Dave Stehouwer seconded that all CI-4 MRV samples generated after 2001 be evaluated using agitation and the modified D-4684 MRV method (external pre-heat). After considerable discussion regarding the effect of this proposed change on the CI-4 ballot and an affirmation from Chris May that the two versions of D-4684 did not produce statistically different results on the wide range of oils they evaluated, this motion somehow disappeared. In its place, a motion by Lyle Bowman appeared, seconded by Pat Fetterman. Lyle moved that an information letter be issued by the TMC to indicate the desires of the T-10 Task Force to use only one method for evaluating CI-4 MRV results, namely, the modified D-4684 (external pre-heat) with agitation. This motion was voted on and passed via voice vote, with none against and no abstentions.

- 6.2 The modified MRV method Research Report is in progress.

7.0 Break

- 7.1 At this point, a more or less 10 minute break occurred.

8.0 Cummins M-11 EGR

- 8.1 Dave Stehouwer reported that the M-11 EGR Research Report has been compiled and approved by the Task Force. It is posted on the TMC web site.

9.0 CAT 1R

- 9.1 The 1R Research Report is in progress.

10.0 "B" Report

10.1 Jim McGeehan announced that he will report to sub-committee B that all negatives have been resolved or withdrawn and all other changes to the CI-4 ballot are editorial. He thanked the panel and all the Task Forces for their hard work (Attachment 8).

11.0 "B" Ballot to use Seq. III-F for Seq. III-E

11.1 There was a negative from Infineum on a D-4485 revision ballot to permit use of the Seq. III-F test for the unavailable Seq. III-E in the CG-4 and CH-4 categories (Attachment 9). The negative objected to use of the phrase "and longer drain intervals" in the description of the Seq. III-F. Pat Fetterman moved and Tom Cousineau seconded that the phrase "and longer drain intervals" be removed from the Seq. III-F description in D-4485. The motion passed via voice vote, with none against and no abstentions.

11.2 Comments on the ballot by Paul Hobson, concerning pass / fail limit percentages, were incorrect and not acted upon.

11.3 Comments by Mike McMillan, regarding the phrase "under development" applied to the Seq. III-F, were not acted upon. According to Lyle Bowman, the test is still "under development" until it becomes a standard and a "D" number is assigned.

12.0 Next Meeting

12.1 Chairman McGeehan put up a slide (Attachment 10) showing the pending emissions regulations timetable and thus the need to start work on PC-10. At this time, the next meeting is planned for June, 2002, in Montreal.

13.0 Adjournment

13.1 The meeting was adjourned at 11:20 a.m.

Jim Wells:

Re your request for copies of the slides that I used at Miami, they have already been discarded. However, most of what was on them was contained in my written comments in response to the CI-4 ballot. Nevertheless, I think I can reconstruct the slides and these follow:

Slide 1

The Form and Style for ASTM Standards says in A7.1.1 that “All significant terms that may have a meaning more specialized or more restricted than the common dictionary meaning should be defined within the standard,

The common dictionary definitions for “anchor” do not remotely relate to the purpose of the maximum numerical values in the Mack T-10 Merit Rating System.

Also, there is no definition for “anchor” provided in the proposed revision to the standard.

Slide 2

My dictionary gives six definitions for “anchor”: 1. A device, usually of metal, attached to a ship or boat by a cable and cast overboard to hold it in a particular place by means of a fluke that digs into the bottom. 2. A reliable support – MAINSTAY. 3. Something that serves to hold an object firmly. 4. An object shaped like a ship’s anchor. 5. ANCHORMAN. 6. *pl. slang* the brakes of a motor vehicle.

Slide 3

Proposed definition for “anchor”

anchor, n – an arbitrary term describing a flexible maximum numerical performance value.

A preferable and more suitable alternative term is “target”.

My dictionary has four definitions for “target” as a noun and one definition as a verb. The most applicable noun definitions are “a mark to shoot at” and “a goal to be achieved”. The verb definition is “to set as a goal”.

1. Insert A A footnote such as “I” is required on scuffing in the Cat 1R, Cat 1K and Cat 1N three-test limits, to define how multiple tests with scuffing are averaged. Compare to the Cat 1P and Cat 1K tests in Table 3. Tests with scuffing should be non-interpretable.
2. Insert D Table A10.1, we question some of the decimal places. Specifically, Cat 1R WDR has no decimal place. Should it have one decimal place? 1K WDK and 1N WDN do. Cat 1R TLC has two decimal places. Should it have one? 1K TLHC and 1N TLHC do. Cummins M11 EGR TRWL has one decimal place. Should it have none? Mack T-10 TRWL has none. Cummins M11 EGR OFDP has four decimal places (2.7000). Are they all justified?
3. Insert D, Table A10.2, Average Liner Wear is incorrect. It is not normalized to 1.75% soot.
4. Insert D, Table A10.2, minimums should be listed for each parameter. Definitions for anchor, maximum and minimum also need to be included.

If these issues are resolved, Ethyl will vote Affirmative on this ballot.

5. Column heading should be “One-test”, to be consistent with “Two-test” and “Three-test”. Same comment for Insert A.
6. Cat 1P, is it “scuffing, piston-ring-liner” or “scuffing, piston-rings-liner”? Note that for the 1K, 1N and 1R, “ring” is used, not “rings”.
7. Cat 1K, for TGF and TLHC, it should be “% max”.
8. Cummins M-11, should be Average Engine Sludge
9. Cummins M11, is it Rocker Pad Average Weight Loss or Crosshead Average Weight Loss? Should be consistent with Cummins M1 EGR.
10. Sequence IIIE (D 5533) and EOAT, for two-test and three-test limits, is it “MTAC” or “MTEP”?

11. D-892 Foam Sequence III is spelled incorrectly.
12. Footnote I, is it uninterpretable or non-interpretable?

14. Suggest dropping the decimal place for Cat 1R WDR and Cat 1N WDN. This would be consistent with the Cat 1P and Cat 1K (see Table 3).
15. Cummins M11 EGR, is it Crosshead Average Weight Loss or Rocker Pad Average Weight Loss? Should be consistent with Cummins M11.
16. Cummins M11 EGR, suggest “normalized to 4.6% average soot, mg max”.
17. Sequence IIIF and EOAT, for two-test and three-test limits, is it “MTAC” or “MTEP”?
18. Footnote AL, suggest “The T-10A, currently under development,...”

19. Section 4.1.8.1, should have a footnote referencing RR:D02-1273 (Cat 1K).
20. Section 4.1.8.1, the Cat 1K does not measure ring wear.
21. Section 4.1.8.3, linear should be liner.
22. Section 4.1.8.3, should not have a footnote, since the T-9 now has a D-number.
23. Section 4.1.8.5, particularly is misspelled.

24. Insert B (Paragraph 4.1.9, CI-4), should have several footnotes identifying research reports or mentioning that test methods are under development: section 4.1.91, 1R; section 4.1.9.2, T-10; 4.1.9.3, M11 EGR; 4.1.9.5, Sequence IIIF; 4.1.9.6, 1K and 1N; 4.1.9.8, EOAT; 4.1.9.15, Elastomer Compatibility Test.
25. Section 4.1.9.6, the Cat 1K does not measure ring wear.


