### CALL TO ORDER

ASTM D02.B0.08, the Test Monitoring Board, met on Monday, June 16, 2008 at 5:00 p.m. in the Plaza A room of the Hyatt Regency Vancouver in Vancouver, British Columbia. There were seven voting members, five non-voting members, and two visitors present. The attendance roster is shown in Attachment A. Minutes from the December 3, 2007 meeting were approved.

#### MEMBERSHIP

The TMB voting membership was reviewed and is shown in Attachment B.

### ADMINISTRATIVE GUIDANCE COMMITTEE

Chris Castanien presented the Administrative Guidance Committee report (see Attachment C). The TMC ended FY 2007 with revenue minus expense of \$+178,000. The TMC was awarded a four-year contract to serve as the ACC Monitoring Agency and the ATC European Registration Centre. As approved at the December meeting, two people have been added to the TMC staff bringing the total full-time head count to 15. The FY 2008 budget was updated based on these significant changes in revenue and expense. The updated budget for FY 2008 projects a small deficit of \$-33,000 with the possibility of an additional \$75,000 to \$100,000 of income from the Sequence VID matrix program. TMC reserves are at 17.3 months of operating expense. As part of the budget planning process for FY 2009, the AGC will evaluate the possibility of reducing test/oil fees.

### **TECHNICAL GUIDANCE COMMITTEE**

Bill Buscher reported that the Technical Guidance Committee had not met in the past year. He stated that the TGC will begin work on a project to develop a compilation of "best practices in lubricant test development." He plans to form a small working group to develop a draft.

### DATA COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE

Frank Farber submitted the Data Communications Committee report (see Attachment D). The DCC did not meet during the past six months. The only current activity of the DCC is beta testing of report packet revisions.

### **TEST MONITORING CENTER**

John Zalar presented the TMC report (see Attachment E). The annual TMC financial audit was completed and the results were favorable.

Seventeen information letters were issued by the TMC and were balloted within Subcommittee B. There were no negative votes and no comments.

The work associated with the ACC Monitoring Agency and ATC European Registration Centre has been progressing successfully.

Earlier this year, SAE asked ASTM to take over complete responsibility for the deposit/distress rating workshops, including the publication and sale of all rating manuals and aids. The TMC will continue to organize and conduct the workshops, one light-duty and one heavy-duty workshop per year. ASTM has agreed to handle the sale and maintenance of the rating manuals and aids through their publications department. The TMB discussed the importance of the rating manuals and aids and the need to ensure the proper care and handling of these materials for the industry. The TMB expressed their support for the TMC to act as a liaison between the industry and the ASTM publications department and funnel information back and forth on any issues relating to the rating manuals and aids (revisions, corrections, re-supply, and so on). Further, the TMB expressed support for the formation of a Deposit/Distress Rating Advisory Panel within Subcommittee B to address future issues relating to rating workshops and rating manuals/aids. Action: The TMB passed a motion to recommend that Subcommittee B form a Deposit/Distress Rating Advisory panel having representation from the TMC and Sections 1, 2, 3, and 6.

### NEXT MEETING

The next meeting is scheduled for December 8, 2008 in Tampa, Florida.



### ADMINISTRATIVE/FINANCIAL

The TMC financial audit for the period February 1, 2007 through January 31, 2008 was completed in March by Lally, Lally & Co. LLC. The outcome of the audit was favorable. A copy of the audit report has been electronically distributed to the Test Monitoring Board. The current financial status of the TMC and updated 2008 budget will be part of the Administrative Guidance Committee report.

As approved by the TMB at the December 3, 2007 meeting, the TMC has added two staff positions. Michael Kasimirsky re-joined the TMC on March 24, 2008 in the position of Staff Engineer. Mike worked as a TMC staff engineer from 1992 to 2005, when his employment was terminated as part of the actions taken to reduce TMC expenses. Mike's primary responsibilities will be monitoring the high-volume bench tests (EOFT, EOWT, BRT, EOEC, CBT, and HTCBT). We were very pleased to welcome Mike back, especially knowing that he would be immediately productive. Colleen Barry was hired on April 8, 2008 to fill the new position of Technical Associate. Colleen's responsibilities will be primarily in IT support. The TMC now has 15 full-time employees. The updated TMC organizational chart is shown in Attachment A.

The contract between ASTM and Carnegie Mellon University (CMU) was renewed for one year on February 1, 2008.

All seventeen letters are on the regular Spring Subcommittee B information letter ballot (08-02). The results of this ballot will be reported at the TMB meeting on June 16, 2008.

### ACC / ATC PROJECTS

ASTM International (on behalf of the TMC) and the American Chemistry Council have entered into a four-year agreement to have the TMC serve as the ACC Monitoring Agency and the ATC European Registration Centre. On January 1, 2008, the TMC began registering candidate tests for the ACC Code of Practice and both candidate and reference tests for the ATC Code of Practice. This work is progressing successfully.

### CURRENT STATUS OF RATING WORKSHOPS AND RATING AIDS

Last December, I reported that the TMC had entered into a contract with SAE International to continue serving as the rating workshop coordinator, as we had previously done for the CRC. In February of this year, SAE abruptly announced that they no longer wanted to oversee the rating workshop activities or handle the publication and sale of the rating manuals and aids. SAE stated their intention to immediately terminate the contract with the TMC and suggested that the responsibilities for the workshops and rating aids be transferred to ASTM. After some discussion, ASTM headquarters agreed to accept the existing inventory of rating aids to store, maintain, and sell. They also felt it was appropriate for the TMC to continue conducting the workshops, since this activity had previously received the approval of the Test Monitoring Board and Subcommittee D02.B. In fact, the most recent rating workshop, held in San Antonio the week of May 12, was organized and conducted by the TMC without any SAE involvement.

The rating manuals and other rating aids are extremely important to our industry. The proper care and maintenance of these materials are of great concern. I believe that the TMC is positioned to play an important role as liaison between the industry and the ASTM publications department. For example, the TMC could funnel information about needed updates and/or corrections to rating manuals and aids from the industry to ASTM; and they could funnel information about the re-supply of manuals and aids from ASTM to the industry. At the June meetings, I will be requesting the support of the TMB and Subcommittee B for establishing this liaison.

During this same time period, the TMC made 244 shipments of reference oils containing a total of 1,633 individual oil samples.

During the period from November 1, 2007 to April 30, 2008, 1463 calibration tests were reported to the TMC. Virtually 100% of all tests reported to the TMC are transmitted electronically.


