Report of Meeting  
L-37 Surveillance Panel  
PRI Headquarters, Apollo Room, Warrendale, Pa.  
June 15, 2005

Sign-in/Review of Membership: The meeting was called to order at 08:06 a.m. The sign-in sheet is *Attachment 1*. There were no membership changes to report and is included as *Attachment 2*.

Meeting Agenda: The meeting agenda was reviewed and is included as *Attachment 3*.

Approval of Meeting Minutes:

**Motion 1** ⇒ Mr. Koehler, Second ⇒ Mr. Koglin -- The panel approved the April 6, 2005 Surveillance Panel meeting minutes, April 21, 2005 teleconference, and May 18, 2005 Panel teleconference meeting minutes with no corrections. The motion to approve the minutes was unanimous.

Summary of Meeting Discussions

2003 L247/T758A Lubrited Matrix -

The Panel, at the April Panel meeting, approved conducting Phase 6 of this hardware test matrix (low temperature testing plan). The three labs (Afton, PARC, and Lubrizol) that participated in the hardware purchase agreed to conduct 2 tests each (1 test on TMC 152 and 153). *Attachment 4* details a summary of 2005 activity to this point.

Mr. Lind reviewed the Phase 6 data generated to date and is included as *Attachment 5*. Five tests have completed to date with one more to be run by lab D. One test was technically invalid because it was stopped 1 minute short of the procedure requirement due to a facility wide power failure). However, the data was included for this presentation because it was felt that shorting the test time by 1 minute would not have changed the outcome of the test. Lab D has yet to finish their final test. Out of the 5 tests, 3 of them would have failed based on the pass/fail criteria. Mr. Koglin asked about the range of Pitting/Spalling values observed in the standard L-37 test matrix. The chairman reported that Pitting/Spalling on the Standard matrix tests failed 4 out of 16 runs.

Options included:

- Run more tests to confirm magnitude of correction factor options.
- Do not approve the hardware for Canadian testing.
- Approve the hardware for use in Canadian testing knowing that formulators might have to run more candidates to get a pass.

**Motion 2** ⇒ Mr. Groppe, Second ⇒ Mr. Buitrago -- Labs B, D, and E to run 2 additional tests each on TMC 152 and TMC 153. The testing is to be completed by next LRI.

Labs have minimal hardware left. Mr. Koglin cited that Afton ordered 75 axles and cannot commit to running more donated tests. The chairman reported that the three labs have donated a total of 38 tests, approximately 13 tests per lab. After much discussion, it was determined that the motion essentially failed, no votes in favor, none opposed, and 4 abstentions.

**Motion 3 ⇒ Chris Schenkenberger, Second ⇒ Mr. Buitrago** -- Using L247/T758A lubrited hardware provided by Lubrizol, Lab B, D, and E to run 2 additional tests on TMC 152 and 2 additional tests on TMC 153. The testing is to be completed and reported by Friday August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2005 for review and action at the August 24<sup>th</sup> L37 Panel meeting. The motion passed with 3 votes in favor, none opposed, and 2 abstentions.

The goal of the panel is to have 9 tests on each oil that would then be satisfactory to develop correction factors.

It was suggested that we ask the raters to take another look at the gears (rate for consensus) because of a concern that there are lab-to-lab variations. Mr. Koglin suggested that we send the existing 5 tests from Phase 6 of this matrix to the July rating workshop. The raters would rate both ring and pinions for all distresses. Mr. Lind confirmed that there would be time for the raters to perform the rating task on the gears on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the workshop.

**Motion 4 ⇒ Cory Koglin, Second ⇒ Chris Schenkenberger** -- The 5 gear sets (ring/pinion) from L247/T758A matrix, Phase 6, be sent to the July 2005 rating workshop for consensus ratings. All distresses on both ring and pinions to be rated. The motion passed with 4 votes in favor, none opposed, and 1 abstention.

Note: Gears should be sent ASAP to the attention of Brian Koehler at SwRI.

**2005 Non-Lubrited Hardware Order -**

The Chairman provided an update to the panel on the order status and is included as attachment 6. Dana intends to build out the gears and deliver by the end of 2005. We are still waiting word on the new Dana representative to the ASTM surveillance panels as the Dana Corporation phasing out of the Statesville facility is still not fully defined. The chairman will provide more information when it becomes available.

New Business: None at this time.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:15 (Mr. Smith motion/second Mr. Koglin).
