Report of Meeting L-37 Surveillance Panel Meeting US Army TACOM Warren, MI

August 12, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 1:45pm.

1.0 Approval of Minutes:

• May 13, 2009 Surveillance Panel Meeting

Motion # 1 → Mr. McGlone/second Mr. Comfort to approve the minutes as presented. Motion for approval was passed with a vote of 9 for, 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions.

2.0 Summary of Meeting Discussions

2.1 Discuss acceptance bands for new shipments of reference oils and requirements of suppliers

The TMC recently reordered 5 drums of reference oil TMC 152. The analytical results from 2 of the 5 drums were different from the other 3 and the historical expectation on phosphorous and boron.

Historically, boron was around 230 ppm and phosphorous was around 1340 ppm. The 2 recent drums were 282 ppm and 287 ppm for boron and phosphorous was 1527 ppm and 1553 ppm, respectively or about 15% higher. The supplier noted that the normal range for boron was 190 to 290 ppm and for phosphorous was 1260-1540 ppm and that these drums were acceptable for distribution. The supplier is willing to work with the TMC and attempt to find a batch that will fall closer to our historical expectation. The supplier has noted that they will not take back the 2 drums.

The panel discussed whether the higher treat rate drums would cause any difference. General consensus was that if treat rate was too high, it may mask test problems with the test. The decision of the panel was to ask the supplier for a blend that is close to historical expectation and get two more drums. After the TMC does an analysis of this oil, the panel will decide how to proceed. One option will be to mix all 7 drums together (or any combination) to achieve an acceptable value.

The group also noticed that the supplier uses the XRF method for analytical analysis and the TMC is using ICP. The panel decided ICP was the preferred method, but when requesting new blends from the supplier, we should use XRF targets.

Motion #2 \rightarrow Mr. Smith/second Mr. Bell – Mr. Lind will ask supplier to see if they can locate 2 drums that are 1420 ppm ±5% phosphorous and 240 ppm ±5% boron by the XRF method (these numbers are the average of the 3 "good" drums). Mr. Lind will report what the supplier was able to locate at the next panel meeting. A decision for

moving forward will be decided by the panel at that time. Motion was approved with a vote of 7 for, 0 opposed, and 1 abstention.

2.2 Hardware Status

The chairman reviewed the recent pilot matrix activity with the panel. The labs have completed two rounds of testing with pilot batch 1 and pilot batch 2. Pilot batch 1 was designed to emulate the 2005 P4L792 hardware batch. After some severe results testing was stopped. Dana suggested a contact pattern shift (re-shim to flank in). Eight remaining axles were modified and tested (pilot batch 2). Preliminary results showed some improvement. Dana will move forward with pilot batch 3 (20 pieces, 10 lubrited, and 10 non-lubrited). The panel discussed changes to be implemented in Pilot batch 3. After reviewing all the results from Pilot batch 2, the Hardware Task Force will decide on a contact pattern to target as well as if additional lapping may be necessary. All labs should be done with testing (pilot batch 2) by Monday, August 17th. Dana needs a decision by end of the week of the 17th on how to proceed with lapping.

Timing – Once gears are lapped they will be shipped to Maumee for assembly. Maumee should receive gears the week of August 24th. There is a mandatory furlough at Dana in early September; therefore, Maumee likely will not have axles ready to ship until mid September.

At the request of Mr. Miller, labs should send EOT photos as well as pre test contact pattern to TMC in PDF format for easy viewing.

 - · Non-lubrited results seemed to improve versus the rejected batch
 - The HTF did notice micro pitting issues
 - · Lubrited seemed to be only a slight improvement over rejected
 - There was one test with broken teeth
 - Most of the "pass" oil runs showed severe pitting/spalling
