## L-60-1 Rating Jig

Scott Parke. presented comments from the January Rating workshop, that the Raters in attendance took a vote and recommended that the rating jig be accepted for use in the industry (A picture of the rig was shown to the panel).

Thomas Gottwald; shared that an outside machine shop was contracted to manufacture these units. The cost will be approximately \$300.00.

Mark Keisler; shared that there are several minor improvements to be made to the prototype used at the January workshop. This will be addressed prior to making more.

There was open discussion that a reference point should be provided to the raters to allow for more consistent view point to evaluate the gears the same between raters.

Scott Parke; these rigs have been used at the workshops have been used for several meetings – and has had favorable response. The raters use this setup in a seated position.

There was a certain amount of discussion over if the raters head should be fixed in space – the raters were not strongly favorable to this. Although this discussion leads some to believe the Rater still used different angles to look at the gears. See attachment #2

Inertek's rater Tony Barrera shared that by using this jig; we've eliminated distance from the light and the angle of the gear to the light, and quite liked it.

Mark Keisler; offer that the final drawings are not prepared yet. Marc shared that they will get these made and will require a 4 week build time.

Jerry Gropp; supports the thought of figuring out how to keep the rater's heads in similar positions.

Allen Comfort; Likes the jig, and fells we've eliminated as much of the variables as we feasible can with this setup.

The panel will review status and any final drawings at the May panel meeting.

Scott Parke; has looked at data and does not feel that it will introduce any additional variability to the test. There are a set of instructions that guide the raters in use of the jig. These instructions will also be reviewed for clarity.

**Motioned** by A. Comfort (US Army) and **Seconded** by M. Keisler (Afton) to approve use of the jig at the labs, labs are to acquire the jig and begin using for all candidate & reference testing beginning with the first reference after August 1<sup>st</sup> 2013. The procedure / instructions will be updated to provide better understand of how to use the Jig when rating. **Passed 7-0-0**

# Attachment #2

## #3 Practice/proposed L-60 Rating Procedure

- Handle the gears at the gear teeth lands to avoid any contact of the rated area.
- Use a cool white type fluorescent 4500 K color temperature light's with a minimum illumination level of 200 foot-candles for rating gears.
- Place the gear on the gear rating fixture with the keyway vertical, front side up.
- Wipe a ¾ inch wide area across the diameter of the face of the gear along the keyway. Wipe the gear five times in the same direction.
- Position the light on gear rating holder on the two brackets on top. Verify light fixture is approximately level in all directions.
- Rate the top half of the gear looking down on the gear, positioning oneself at near eye level. **Gear at 45 degrees, look at gear at same plane, 45 degrees, approx.**
- Do not rate the gear teeth or the spacer bushing contact area.
- Rotate the gear 180 degrees and rate the other half of the gear.
- Turn the gear over and repeat the rating procedure for the back side.
- Use any of the three Rating Scales (A, B or C) for Non-Rubbing Parts in CRC Manual No. 20 to determine the varnish rating.
- Do not use new test parts, such as a gear or the washer nut area of the test gear as a 10.0 rating reference point.
- Use same method for small gear.
