### Information Letter 10-1

ASTM Procedure: IL 10-1 has not been incorporated into the procedure yet. Frank Farber is working on this, and shared that the change was on the Dec ballot (and was cleared) - and should make it into the next printing.

#### **Review of Industry Alarms**

L. Hamilton provided an update of history regarding audits and state of alarm of the reference results: See attachment #3

In an attempt to resolve outliers in reported Pentane / Toluene the TMC audited all the Analytical Labs and found differences in the processes, and request changes to reduce the numbers of outliers.

The question was raised have the Labs checked with their analytical labs to ensure that the new methods have been started.

SWRI - is running to the latest version, not sure on date, but had been more than 9 months.

<u>Intertek</u> – Have only ever run under new procedure.

Afton - Yes, the new procedure since just before last TMC visit ~8 or 9 months ago.

Lubrizol - Yes, April of 2012.

#### Ideas were called for:

- L. Hamilton request the TMC re-audit and verify all changes have been made. Verify targets are correct
- B. Koehler at one point we discussed dropping pentane and toluene from monitoring, should we discuss this again?
- J. Gropp if we drop it from referencing, but is part of various spec levels, we could have it come back and bite us.
- L. Hamilton if we aren't' drawing the oil samples at EOT the same, that could be a cause. Should we audit this process in greater detail?
- S. Parke showed Comparisons from the last audit go around differences between labs.
- B. Koehler Have we looked at raw data for control charts? If so, then consider changing targets. Brian requested we look at the charts in real limits (TMC responded that's not how the limits and targets are set)
- M. Keisler Afton doesn't want to remove pentane / toluene from the test.

S. Parke - shared data plotted from the 30 test targets ("updated") to show that it helps to various degrees, but doesn't solve the problem. This was because the initial targets were set with a smaller data set.

TMC will re-audit- analytical labs and see EOT at his next visit for L-60-1 to each lab.

- L. Hamilton let's look at data, transformed and untransformed.
- B. Koehler asked if we should look at the transformation itself currently being used this has been done before.

#### Summary and end result of discussion:

S. Parke of the TMC will audit Testing Labs and look at D893 in the analytical labs over the next 3 months. TMC will also update plots in LTMS.
