Approval of previous meeting minutes. The minutes for the 9/8/2018 teleconference were approved unanimously and without comment.

Rating Manual Review. Review is complete and a draft was distributed to the Task Force. TMC will research on how to proceed with the revision within ASTM.

Heavy Duty Rating Workshop Review. Discussion of the October 2018 Heavy Duty Workshop. The group discussed how the targets were set for the C13 Ring Carbon ratings, which used all raters for the targets, versus the first session target raters only. It was suggested that the Target Raters be used for setting all targets in the workshop.

The discussion moved to offering some type of introductory session for new raters. Several suggestions for how such a session could be offered to the industry were discussed. This session needs to be the week before the regular workshop to ease international travel issues.

Precision Estimates for Small N-sizes. Brief discussion regarding using a standard deviation calculated from historical workshop data on parts with a small target rater N size. Much more work is required before this can move forward.

LED Lighting. Task Force will send out a summary of the LED conversion hardware to use for converting a fixture to LED. Labs will use these converted fixtures to generate rating data using LED light and will submit the dual rating data to TMC for summary.

Light Duty Rating Workshop is May 6-10, 2018.

The next meeting will be prior to the 2019 Light Duty Rating Workshop, in mid-April.
